The bakery has rapidly become a thriving economic center, producing an impressive 180 loaves of bread daily for commercial sale. Beyond generating income, the bakery fulfills a critical community need by reserving over 100 loaves of bread for cooking, ensuring access to freshly baked goods for local families.

By creating economic opportunities and enhancing food security, the bakery has elevated the overall well-being of Qara Wool's residents.
