## **STITCHING DREAMS INTO REALITY:** Empowering Women through the Kanam Tailoring Shop

In the serene village of Kanam, nestled within the picturesque region of Imam Sahib, a transformative journey of empowerment and entrepreneurship is unfolding. Through the establishment of a tailoring shop by the industrious members of the Women's Self-Help Group (WSHG), a community once limited by economic constraints now thrives with hope, resilience, and opportunity.

This journey began with the dedicated efforts of the AWARE project's female trainers, who equipped the women of Kanam with vital skills and knowledge. From financial literacy and business strategies to family well-being and Integrated Pest Management (IPM), these trainings were the foundation upon which the women built their confidence and capabilities. Inspired by this support, the WSHG members decided to turn their skills into a sustainable source of income, pooling 42,400 Afghanis to bring their vision of a tailoring shop to life.

Recognizing the need for scale and versatility, they acquired a larger sewing machine, enabling them to meet diverse tailoring demands within the community.

By employing a male tailor to sew garments for men, the shop not only expands its service offerings but also promotes gender equity by creating employment opportunities for both men and women. This decision underscores the group's vision of fostering inclusivity and shared prosperity within Kanam.

The Shura deputy's generous provision of shop space exemplifies the harmony between the WSHG and local leadership, showcasing the power of collective action and partnership in achieving sustainable development. Today, the vibrant hum of sewing machines and the steady flow of customers reflect the shop's growing impact. Beyond generating income for the women involved, the initiative empowers them with a sense of self-reliance and pride.
